International experiences on how to face gender violence will be reported, thanks to the participation of Prof. Maria Nittis, Director of the Department of Forensic Clinical Unit of the New South Wales Department of Health of Sydney (Australia), and of Prof. Eric Baccino, Professor of Legal Medicine of the University of Montpellier and Head of the Legal Medicine Service of the University Hospital Center (C.H.U.) in Montpellier, where around 2000 victims of violence are assisted each year.
